

## HIGHLIGHTS FROM PAST SAUSAGE SUPPERS & SALEM UCC EVENTS

1949	<b>First Sausage Supper</b> - 2 hogs Were Donated Church Council Expanded to 12 members.
1950	Sausage Supper Was Served from 4:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Bought 18 dozen Chairs and 13 tables Women were Given the Right to Vote. Pastor said he doubled the membership. The Ground Breaking for the Parish Hall was in March. .
1951	April 1st was the Dedication of the Parish Hall. 600 people attended
1952	Sausage House was built in November
1954	Butchered at Harold Landolt's Butcher Shop. Bought 100 folding chairs and Julius Hosto was in charge of stenciling them.
1955	Families received free tickets to the Sausage Supper if they donated a hog.
1956	Gilbert Hosto donated 25 crocks.
1957	The Women's Guild served a dinner on Processing Day.
1958	Bought a piano and Bought 6 more tables.
1959	The hogs were purchased from Henry Klenke. Bought a Refrigerator.
1963	Purchased 1/2 of Potato mixer and Women's Guild paid for the other 1/2.
1964	A Water Hydrant was put in the Sausage House. Purchased Pasteurized Milk instead of Milk donated from the Farm. Purchased a second refrigerator and 2 carts for the kitchen. Purchased a 80 gallon hot water heater and more burners for the Sausage House.
1965	Otto Ullman donated 12 tubs for sausage.
1969	Meat was purchased from Krey Packing Co. <b>First Carry-outs were made available.</b>
1972	The Educational Building was dedicated.
1976	Processing was at Jack Frandsen's Farm.
1977	Church was remodeled and passageway built to connect all of the buildings.
1978	Hog slaughtering took place at Korte-Richter.
1980	Purchased 9 dozen forks, 3 dozen knives and 3 dozen spoons.
1982	Blizzard started during the Sausage Supper, there was No Church the next day.
1983	State ordered Processing to take place at Korte-Richter.
1987	Plans for an Elevator began for the Parish Hall.
1988	Elevator Building started on February 23.
1994	Pie Shelves were built by Delmar Korsmeyer.
1995	The kitchen was remodeled. For the First time, over 2,000 people were served.
1996	The Sausage House was remodeled.
1998	<b>50th Anniversary of the Sausage Supper.</b> Record number of Dine - in meals. 1593
2003	The Carry-Outs were moved to the Educational Building.
2004	A New garage (Storage Shed) was built behind the Parish Hall.
2005	Started cutting up meat on Wednesday and finishing on Thursday
2006	Gehrig's Store closes in November, supplier of groceries, paper products, propane, appliances and repairs to many electrical and plumbing problems at the Church. Jim's IGA in Livingston started suppling our groceries and paper products.
2008	A New Handicap Bathroom was installed in the Educational Building.
2010	Salem UCC Celebrated 150 Years of Ministry.
2014	Salem begins Livestreaming Church Services and Special events in October
2015	new record set 2347 served,
2017	Jim's IGA closes, Bill's IGA in Staunton supplies our paper products and groceries. Replaced chairs in Parish Hall (Over 350 Chairs)
2018	New record of carryouts - 1084
